Potable (drinking water, etc.) and reserve carry 24,950 gallons of potable water which is used per day by the crew. This figure falls if laundry is not run. Boiler reserve feed water is used at the rate of 3000 gallons per day.

The evaporator can produce about 15000 gallons of fuel to accomplish this.

There are six drinking water tanks which are located in the pump room, compartment A-404-E. The main water tank out the ship is also located in the pump room.
