NAVOCEANO

Under the direction of Don Milligan, the team of ten scientists from NAVOCEANO took a total of 163 oceanographic stations in the icy waters north of Russia. Although the nature of these stations varied, the entire spectra of observation included Nansen casts, large volume water samples, cores, bottom grabs, and plankton, radiation, and air samples. The work also included three current stations. This entire survey was made in an area previously unexplored by U.S. vessels and it should prove to fill an extensive gap in our bank of oceanographic data.
