

liberty in thule



The Air Force base at Thule is staffed by maybe fifteen hundred persons and operates primarily as a part of the United States' defense program. As a liberty port it's not too much. Scenically it boasts of uniquely shaped Dundas Mountain (below), a small but taboo eskimo village, and one grassy hillside.

Perhaps Thule's greatest asset is its multitude of bulging warehouses whose goodies are free for the asking. The freighters escorted in each year resupply these caches which in turn resupply the escorting vessels, the icebreakers.
