

# COMMISSARYMEN



Around 0530 every morning the BMOW wakes up either CS1 Sales, CS2 Navat, or CS2 Gotaskie to start another long day in the galley. One of them starts to put together the morning meal which usually consists of eggs with bacon or ham, and sometimes pancakes.

After securing morning chow at 0800 the duty cook starts preparing the noon meal. This is the largest meal and most of the morning is spent preparing it. Nine can often be seen peeling spuds in the port air castle while Navat chops up some fresh greens for a salad.

In dry stores Masterson keeps a strict inventory on all commissary items. He also makes out orders for stores for each UNREP and VERTREP.

Evening chow takes most of the afternoon to fix and about one hour to serve. The galley is cleaned and locked up until the duty baker takes over. He might work half the night depending on how much is needed. After midnight rats have been placed on the mess deck, Uncle Sal's Country Kitchen is closed for another day.
